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Vase mit spitzen Blättern, Hersteller unbekannt, Tschechoslowakei, um 1930?

Dear Siegmur,

I would be very grateful if you could help identify this large press moulded glass vase which I recently acquired. It is approximately 9 inches high and features an 8 sided stepped base and a relief moulded pattern of 8 vertical jagged leaves, the top surface of which has been frosted. It is from a four part mould and appears to be a very well made piece. The body of the vase is comparatively light and delicate and the leaves stand out to a depth of about 1 cm. Although I bought it in England, I do not believe it to be an English piece and I can't immediately suggest a maker. It comes with an 8 pointed star shape flower separator which I have also pictured.
