IVIMA was founded in 1895 by the Count of Azaruinha. It started with the name of Companhia Nacional, although it has had various names throughout its life. It also had different owners such as Vista Alegre, Cive,

and Crisal. In 1998 it was bought out by the Atlantis Group, an organization that does international sales of glass. [GSW, [PK 2006-2](#), pp. 239-257, [complete history of the company](#)]

Forms: (measurements may vary 1/16") **No mould marks are known**, but labels do appear on the hens. Known colors include **amber, pale green, cobalt, transparent blue, clear, milk glass, and translucent smoky brown**. The company also made an uncovered # 8388 eggcup: 3.8" x 2.16", 2.88" tall.

 Bottom of base is plain with no pattern. Head turns to the right, unlike most hen dishes. One egg on the right front; two eggs on the left front; one egg each side in the back at the base of the solid tail.
