Hi Siegmar,

You have helped me on several occasions with opaque glass pieces that were unidentifiable in the U.S. & I am only contacting you after submitting this piece to the Milk Glass Collectors Society, Old Milk Glass Collectors, American Museum of Glass & going through all eight U.S. milk glass references from the 1940s until present day. Also the European Glass Board, Glass Messages. Everyone has looked for it & come up empty. Its a Scotty / Scottie (or at least that is what it looks like) dogs head covered mustard. Its the old firey opalescent around the edges & has wear & strawmarks, height 4" & diameter 2 1/2". It is not new, it does have considerable age. Anyway before giving up entirely I thought I would send it to you to see if you recognize it as being European. Any information is most appreciated although granted it may be a piece where only a few were made & that is why no one can find anything even though supposedly its created a bit of a sensation among milk glass collectors.

sorry, I never saw this interesting dog head and I have no idea from where it may come. I could imagine that it was most probable produced in England: the milk glass, the dog ...

Scotties were most popular in the **1930ies** in **Europe**. The race of Scottish Terriers was bred already at the end of 19th century (look for Wikipedia EN Scottish_Terrier ... Famous Scotties and popular culture).

But they got popular only when they were not more used as helpdogs by hunters or as watchdogs but by noble ladies as companions on the streets ... President **Roosevelt** was renowned for owning a Scottie named Fala. He loved Fala so much that he rarely went anywhere without him. He had several Scotties before Fala, including one named Duffy and another named Mr. Duffy. Eleanor Roosevelt had a Scottish Terrier named Meggie when the family entered the White House in **1933**. ... The Scottie is also renowned for being featured in the popular board game, **Monopoly**, as a player token. When the game was first created in the **1930s**, Scotties were one of the most popular pets in the United States ... [Wikipedia EN]

Your glass dog could be a **West Highland White Terrier** - The modern breed is descended from a number of breeding programs of white terriers in Scotland prior to the **20th century** ... The breed remains very popular in the UK and is in the top third of all breeds in the US since the 1960s [Wikipedia EN]. They were together with black scotties used by Scottish whisky Black & White from the **1890s**. But **Czech Terriers** (Český Teriér) were not bred before **1949** [http://cs.wikipedia.org/wiki/Český_teriér].
